Luke 22 Gethsemane prayer for prayer series week 9

Warm up question 1. When you face a trial in life, do find you are more or less likely to pray? Why?

Warm up question 2. In your prayers, do you pray for God's saving plan for Kiwis not to fail? Why/why not?

As we continue to grow in prayer, we come to Jesus' prayer as he faces the ultimate trial of whether to draw back from the suffering of the cross: Instead he prays for God's saving plan not to fail.

Pray. We're focusing on 22:39-46, but let's read the before and after context too. **Read Luke 22:31-53**

First reactions:

- What do you make of the business about swords? [the commentators suggest that its about readiness for standing with the one now called 'a transgressor' v37. So in summary: It's about readiness to face opposition, not about exerting force or taking revenge, as per v51.]
- How many times does prayer come up in the whole passage? And prayer for what?

Jumping to the heart of the passage, v42.

- 1. In the first part of Jesus' prayer, what is the cup he wants to be taken from him? (Look up and read Isaiah 51:17-22 to help answer this question.)
- In the second part of Jesus' prayer what is more important than his own desire? What is 'this will' referring to? [God's saving plan for the nations: in place of fair condemnation for sin, merciful forgiveness, pardon & justification for sinners]
- 3. How does the Father answer Jesus' prayer according to v43?
- 4. The pattern with Jesus is: trial then prayer then strengthening. Do you agree?
- 5. How do we see this pattern seen with the Apostles, for example in v31-32? [i.e.v31-32 What are the trials they face? What is the prayer prayed for them – by whom? Where does strengthening come from?]
- 6. Why is this pattern helpful for us to see? [at the least it is instructive: urging us to pray in midst of trials. Even more: it is encouraging to notice God answers his people]
- Whose will is being done in v47-53? [there is more than one answer!]
- 8. How does Jesus' prayer help us to pray?

[Because of his determination for God's saving plan not to fail, we can come to be saved from judgement into living relationship with the living God]

9. How does Jesus; prayer teach us to pray?

[while his situation concerns the saving of the world, we can still pray in our circumstances 'help me do what you want']
