Pray and Read Genesis 39:1-23

- 1. First reactions: do you like this episode or not? Why?
- 2. Context question. Judah & brothers sold him: why? Does the place Joseph ends up seem positive or negative: why?
- 3. Of those who are named in vv2-6, who is doing what? are we told why?
- 4. From what happens to Joseph in vv6-11, what do learn is most important to him? how does he show this in practice?
- 5. How would you describe his "reward for faithfulness" in vv11-20?
- 6. What is different in vv20-23 and what the same, when compared with vv2-6?
- 7. How much do people entrust to Joseph in this chapter? Where do they do this? Why do they entrust what they do to him?
- 8. Joseph is like a forerunner to Jesus. What are we given about Jesus to help us entrust ourselves to him?
- 9. What parts of life might even Christians hold back from Jesus?
